

How to Let Students Submit Files From Their Google Drive

When you create an assignment as a **file upload submission**, it allows students to upload content directly from their Google Drive. This creates a **snapshot** of the file at the time it is submitted (so you are not viewing a live document when you grade). It also allows you to grade the assignment using **SpeedGrader**.

1) Follow the steps to create a new assignment. In the "Submission Type" drop down menu, select "Online." Then, select "File Uploads."

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
2) Continue adding assignment details, and click "Save." That's it!
